URGENT: Stage 3 Water Conservation

Tofino is in the midst of a severe drought which requires urgent conservation measures. The public is urged to decrease consumption by 25% immediately to avoid Stage 4 water restrictions and a potential local state of emergency that would significantly impact all residents and visitors on the Esowista Peninsula. Every drop counts.

All outdoor water use is prohibited during Stage 3:

- No pressure washing, window or boat washing.
- No vehicle or bicycle washing.
- No landscape, garden, lawn or food plant watering.
- No hot tub or pool top ups or fill ups.
- · No outdoor showering.

What can I do to help?

- Showers & toilets account for 44% of daily household water use.
- Flush less, take shorter showers, put bricks in toilet tanks.
- Run dishwashers and laundry only when full.
- Re-use greywater for non essentials (gardens, lawns, etc).
- Use kindness and compassion to spread the word.

Foodsafe and hygienic uses exempt. Rainwater catchment and greywater for non potable uses is encouraged where possible. Check public health guidelines.
